



A week later, the women's swimming and diving team brought home its first NCAA National Championship since 1982. During the meet, the Gators broke five school records and won two national titles, one in the 200-meter free-

style relay and the other in the 100-meter backstroke. Twelve team members earned All-American status. The Gators edged out Stanford by 2.5 points for the second-closest victory in the history of the championship.



UF's Club Alligator Swim Team won two national titles April 18. It was awarded at the American Swimming Association's Collegiate Club Swimming National Championships in Atlanta. The men's club team won one of the

championships for its division, while the second was earned for the best combined men's and women's scores. According to the ASA, UF is the first university to hold both the NCAA and ASA swimming titles in the same year.
